

Seasonal Invasive Species Crew Member Job Opportunity



Mid-May - August 2024

The Chippewa Luce Mackinac Conservation District is seeking interested applicants to serve as Invasive Species Crew Members for the Three Shores Cooperative Invasive Species Management Area. The positions will start as early as May 20th, 2024, and extend through August 2024, with some flexibility on the end date. Applicants selected for this position will be expected to work 40 hours per week with occasional irregular hours, weekends, and overnight trips. This position will require the applicant to conduct fieldwork in all weather conditions and be able to lift and carry 50 pounds daily. Chosen applicants will also be expected to have reliable transportation, as the use of an employee's personal vehicle will be required during employment. The employee will be expected to follow the guidance of their crew leader and will be supervised by the Three Shores CISMA Coordinator.

Essential Job Duties

- Manual, Mechanical, and Chemical treatment of invasive species
- Provide accurate and precise survey, treatment, and monitoring data
- Assist with outreach events
- Assist the needs of partners and private landowners with the utmost professionalism

Required Qualifications

- Valid state driver's license
- Reliable personal transportation
- Ability to pass a federal background check
- Ability to lift and carry 50 lbs
- Strong intangible skills & punctual
- Pursuant of, or obtained, a degree in a natural resources field of study

Preferred Qualifications

- Field experience in Michigan invasive species identification
- FieldMaps and Survey123 proficiency
- Boat and Kayak experience including safe operation and basic maintenance
- Commercial pesticide applicator's license

Location: Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan (Office: 2847 Ashmun St.) Employees will begin each day at the office and conduct assigned field work within Chippewa, Luce, and Mackinac Counties.

Compensation: \$15-16/hour, dependent upon experience. Mileage reimbursement when the use of a personal vehicle is required for travel
